## Shroud

A shroud is something that covers; it is a veil. There is a shroud-like cover that lies heavy over Muslim peoples' heart and mind. It keeps them from seeing the light of Christ. It intercepts the truth and blinds the soul from seeing the glory of God.



The veil you see many Muslim women wear, though it is meant to indicate modesty and religious devotion, symbolically demonstrates the unseen veil that covers the heart of Muslims—men, women and children.

### PRAYER

Awesome God, almighty and majestic, my heart overflows with praise and gratitude because You have rescued me from the dominion of darkness and brought me into the kingdom of the Son You love (Colossians 1:13). Hear my prayer for Muslims. They are darkened in their understanding and they are separated from the life of God because they don't know Christ and their hearts are hardened. (Ephesians 4:18). Have mercy on them, Lord God, and take away the dark veil that covers their hearts (2 Corinthians 3:15). Remove the thick cloud that prevents them from seeing the light of the Sun of Righteousness (Malachi 4:2).
